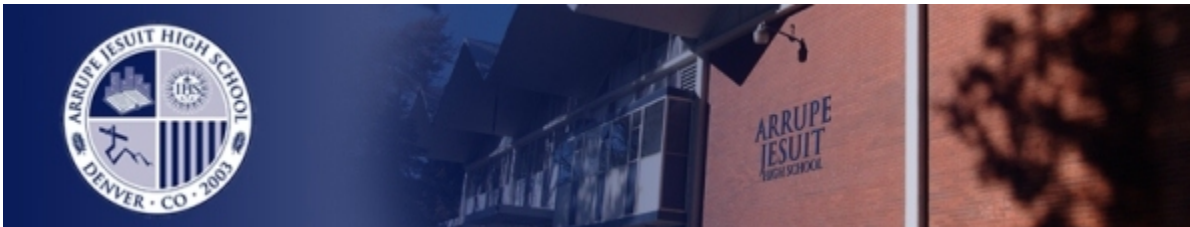

**Arrupe Class of 2012 the Largest to Date**

The Class of 2012 is the largest class to date at Arrupe. The enrolled Freshman class includes 52 males and 59 females for a total of 111. Below is a table listing the demographic information for the class as compared to the entire student body.



Over the summer, all new 111 students participated in a week of computer training where they learned to write cover letters and resumes. This computer training week was followed by two weeks of "corporate boot camp," which included a day at a challenge course. They also spent a day at Regis University and heard several speakers discuss topics such as integrity and goal-setting.
