Dear Friends of Arrupe:

It has been a busy summer here at Arrupe. Phase Two of our construction project began in June after the last day of the school year. This work will help our physical plant be more energy efficient by replacing the original windows with thermal dual pane glass. We are also updating the front entry vestibule of the building by adding a second set of doors to help contain heat loss. New front steps and hand rails will complete the design of the front entrance. These renovations will save us thousands of dollars each year in energy costs. We are now raising funds to complete Phase Three of our campaign next spring, which will include bathroom and gymnasium renovations.

We have welcomed 103 students in the Class of 2013 for summer Corporate Work-Study training. The training includes courses on team building, office machines, business ethics, as well as Dale Carnegie communication and relationship building skills.

We hope you will join us for our annual golf tournament on August 24, 2009. It will be held for the first time at Sanctuary, the premiere venue for golf in Colorado. 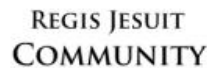

Students Earn Over \$2.7 Million in Merit-Based Scholarships

The Class of 2009 at Arrupe Jesuit High School was awarded diplomas on Friday, May 29, 2009. The 46 students in the Class of 2009 have much to celebrate. For the third year in a row, 100% of Arrupe seniors were accepted into the college or university of their choice, with 80% accepted into a four-year college or university. **The Class of 2009 has also earned over \$2.7 million in merit-based scholarships, setting a school record.** This is impressive for any group of young men and women, but especially so considering that 90% of our seniors are considered first-generation college bound and 50% were the first in their family to graduate high school.

Valedictorian, Elizabeth Khong addressed the audience and thanked everyone for their support throughout the years. She explained that the four years of high school have been marked with memorable opportunities and hard-earned results. Elizabeth continued on to say that students have been shaped physically, mentally, and spiritually, in ways they could not have expected as freshmen. Elizabeth explained, "Over the course of four years, I have learned that my biggest calling in life is to use my knowledge to serve the world. It is important to help others because their challenge in life is our challenge; therefore, we are called to work with those in need to make a positive change." Elizabeth will be attending Regis University in the fall.

Class of 2013 has Arrived!

On July 6th, the Corporate Work-Study Staff welcomed 103 new students who began their three week summer training program. The training workshops, designed to prepare students for their first day on the job in August, include sessions on team building, office machines, business ethics, phone skills, Dale Carnegie communication and relationship building skills, and a host of other topics. This year, Arrupe is fortunate to have over 50 volunteers from companies that hire our students and from other organizations teaching and facilitating the workshops.



The students are off to an enthusiastic start - eager to begin their journey at Arrupe, a journey that will lead them down the path to college admission in 2013!
