Arrupe's Independent Reading Expectation Sets High Standard for English Students

The Arrupe English Department is setting the standard that, in all four years at Arrupe, students will read four books independently each quarter. This expectation is beyond what is considered required reading for English class, and will count as a significant portion of the students' overall grade. In order to help facilitate this, all English teachers are dedicating time in class to independent reading, including the first 15 minutes of every Freshman and Sophomore English class being set aside for independent reading and note-taking.
