### **Keynote Speaker - Fr. Greg Boyle, SJ**



We are honored to have nationally renowned speaker Fr. Greg Boyle, SJ, founder of Homeboy Industries as our keynote speaker at Magis Night this year. Fr. Greg Boyle is a Los Angeles native who was ordained a Jesuit in 1984. He was a prison chaplain, high school teacher, pastor and founder of Jobs for a Future prior to forming Homeboy Industries. Homeboy Industries is recognized as the largest gang intervention program in the county of Los Angeles and has had an important impact on the Los Angeles gang problem, with young people from over half of the region's 1,100 known gangs seeking a way out through Homeboy. Thousands of young people have walked through the doors of Homeboy Industries looking for a second chance, and finding community. Gang affiliations are left outside as these young people work together, side by side, learning the mutual respect that comes from shared tasks and challenges.

Father Greg has chosen to create solidarity with the "homies" he helps, not just being for them but by standing with them. He says it's not about taking the right stand on issues, but about standing in the right place. He doesn't proclaim his message, he is his message. Fr. Greg provides a light in the darkness by providing hope, dignity and a second chance to those who have none.

*Magis* is a Latin word for "more". In the Jesuit tradition, a person who strives for the Jesuit ideal of *Magis* is a man or woman for others. Fr. Greg personifies the message of *Magis* and Arrupe and will delight the audience!
