Mission of Arrupe

Arrupe Jesuit High School is a co-educational, college preparatory school that serves economically disadvantaged students from Denver's inner-city neighborhoods.

To prepare our students for success in college and beyond, Arrupe maintains rigorous academic coursework, high standards of dress and behavior, and a school size that is small enough to provide a nurturing environment and individual attention. All students earn approximately 70% of their tuition by working five days per month at area businesses through the Arrupe Corporate Work-Study Program. Students work at 88 area businesses, including law firms, hospitals, banks, and energy companies. 90% of Arrupe's Class of 2007 and 2008 were first generation college-bound.
