Basketball has strong participant numbers and strong commitment from its members. We are looking for a long-term placement at the head coaching position.

Coaching candidates will...

Possess advanced organization and communication skills

- Our school schedule is incredibly dynamic. A successful coach will keep careful track of how this impacts attendance at games and practices & learning basketball concepts and skills.
- The Head Coach must communicate, prepare, and hold athletes and assistant coaches accountable for attendance and team values and academic performance.
- Expectations of athletes must be clear to athletes. These expectations must be enforced evenly.
- Candidates should have potential assistant coaches in mind and be able to work with previous assistant coaches.

Utilize positive coaching practice

- Our new coach should be passionate about the positive impact and values basketball can offer a young man. The coach will build appropriate relationships with the players and build a positive team culture. This includes cultivating a positive, growth-oriented environment at practices and games that reinforces school and Catholic values.
- Structure tryouts in a way where athletes understand what is required to make various teams, and be prepared for some amount of cuts from tryouts. Similarly, communicate playing time expectations in advance to players and parents.
- Coaches must understand they represent Arrupe in the gym, on the bench and in interactions with parents, faculty, and other external groups.
- Work with other Program Heads to foster a culture of multisport participation, prioritizes physical strength and personal development and emphasizes mental health.
